

Applying for a Library Card

Introduction

To apply for a library card in Saskatchewan, you may fill out an application from the website, <https://saskatoonlibrary.ca>, or visit any local library

Adults and young adults (ages 14+) must show two pieces of identification, one establishing their current address and a second piece that verifies identity. Children under 14 years of age must be with a parent or legal guardian who must show the two pieces of identification mentioned and provide a signature.

Types of ID that you may use

For Adults (ages 18 and older)

- Saskatchewan Driver's License
- Government ID card
- Saskatchewan Vehicle Registration
- Passport
- Postmarked mail with your current
- Address on it

Young Adults (ages 14-17)

- Student Card
- Parent ID (parent must sign for the card)
- Driver's License
- Government ID Card
